

Morning Arrival

School begins at 8:30 am. It is important that students arrive on time, to minimize disruptions to learning. Establishing morning routines are important skills in order to be prepared for the day! Late students come through the office.

School Attendance

Using SafeArrival, Parents/Guardians are required to report their child's absence, late arrival or early departure using **one** of these three methods:

- Toll Free # 1 (844) 435-3440
- SchoolMessenger go.schoolmessenger.ca
- SchoolMessenger App (blue icon) from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.

Pick Up Arrangements and/or Daily Changes

If there are any changes to your child's pick up routine at the end of the day, please let your child know in the morning. We often have children not knowing how they're getting home. Please also communicate to your child's teacher either through note or agenda.

Parents at School

A reminder to parents, if you drop off your child at the school please come into the office. Parents are not allowed to walk through the hallways. Any students that are late, please come to the office first to ensure that we have marked you present.



Class Mass Rotations

Every Wednesday, one class from St. Dominic and Queen of Heaven School will participate in weekly mass at St. Dominic Parish. Classes from Grade 1 to Grade 8 will rotate on a weekly



schedule. They will be waking to church. Students leave at approximately 8:50 am and will return approximately 10:30 am. Please make sure your child is on time for school. At this time, we will not need volunteers to walk with the students and all verification forms were filled out at the beginning of the year for all walking excursions.

Progress Reports and Communication of Learning

The Progress Report (Grades 1-8) and Communication of Learning (Kindergarten) will be sent home electronically on Tuesday,



November 12, 2024. This means that your child's Report Card/Communication of Learning will be sent directly to your child's registered DPCDSB student email account. For example: 123456789@educ.dpcdsb.org This is the same number that they use to log into their computers at school. Your child's teacher will ensure that they have their student numbers and passwords. You will be able to download the report card to have your own copy. The link that will be emailed and will be live for 7 days. Please be aware, that the Progress Reports and the Initial Observations are not a formal Report Card and students will not be receiving letter grades indicating achievement of overall expectations.


